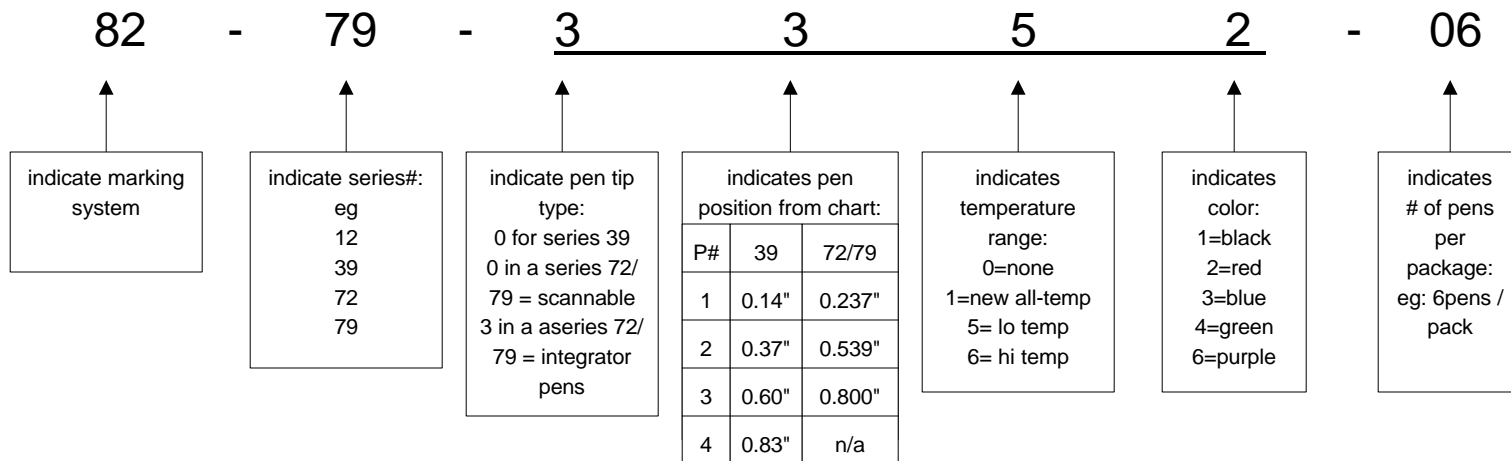


General Pen Description Numbering System

82-79-ABCD-06

eg:

82-79-3352-06



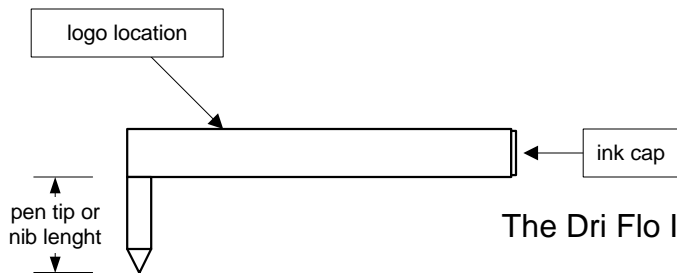
The series 72/79 pens are differentiated from the series 39 by the addition of a "flame" logo on the operator facing edge of the pen (in addition to the "square G" logo that is found on all Graphic Controls pens.) Also, the blue pen and the green pen is angled toward the red pen in an effort to get its recording line to trace closer to the red pen as the red pen is normally the one that is arced and therefore more accurate.

Also the series 39 pens have a ink cap that is gray in color while ther series 72-79 is colored as follows:

Red for hi temp

Blue for low temp

gray for the new all temp pens



The Dri Flo II pens are very similar to the Graphic Controls pens in that their pt# system uses the same core # group (underlined above)and series #'s but in a different order.

eg: a GC # of 82-79-3352-06 = DF part# of DF-14571U335279.

In the DF pens the prefix is ALWAYS DF-14571U... (followed by the core # then the series #)
